### DECEMBER 2015 NEWSLETTER

**LEAF PICK-UP:** After November 23<sup>rd</sup> leaves must be in **biodegradable bags only**.

**SNOW:** As we approach the winter season, we would like to remind everyone that parking on Village streets from **2 AM to 6 AM is prohibited**. If you have a fire hydrant in front of your residence, please help our Volunteer Fire Dept. and keep it cleared of snow.

**CHRISTMAS TREES:** The Village crew will once again be picking up Christmas trees this year. Please place them by the roadside and we will get them as time permits.

**HUNTING:** Hunting of any kind is prohibited in the Village of Lima (Local Law # 5 of 2007).

**WATER/SEWER RELEVY:** Re-levy cut off date is Feb. 25, 2016. All unpaid water and sewer bills will be re-levied onto the 2016-17 village taxes after 2/25/2016.

**BUILDING INSPECTOR:** Please remember that installing wood stoves, gas inserts, pellet or coal stoves require a permit to be issued by the Village. The permit ensures that the installation is in compliance with the Building Code. Wood stoves and chimneys should be checked and cleaned on a regular basis. If you have an existing alternative heating device that burns fuel, a carbon monoxide detector can be an excellent Holiday gift to yourself. These detectors alert the home's occupants to any source of odorless and deadly carbon monoxide. Carbon dioxide detectors need to be located within 15 feet of all bedrooms and on any level that contains a combustion source.

**PARKING:** Please be aware during the winter season that on-street parking is prohibited between 2 AM and 6 AM on all village streets. During snowfalls in excess of 3 inches, parking on village streets where signage allows overnight parking is prohibited, so village crews can complete the snow removal process. Cars left on the street will be eligible for towing at owner's expense.

**BRUSH:** The Village crew picks up brush three (3) times a year (April, July, and September). Please do not put out brush at any other time, as it will not be picked up.
