Mr. Pangrazio presented the following resolution and moved its adoption:

WHEREAS, the New York State Legislature has authorized the County of Livingston to impose an additional 1% local sales and compensating use tax rate; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the County of Livingston to amend its existing Sales and Use Tax resolution to impose such additional rate; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED by the Livingston County Board of Supervisors, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 4-A of Resolution No. 67-190, enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Livingston on November 30, 1967, imposing sales and compensating use taxes, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4-A. Imposition of additional rate of sales and compensating use taxes. Pursuant to the authority of section 1210 of the Tax Law, in addition to the sales and compensating use taxes imposed by sections 2 and 4 of this

resolution, there is hereby imposed and there shall be paid an additional one percent rate of such sales and compensating use taxes, for the period beginning June 1, 2003, and ending November 30, 2017. Such additional taxes shall be identical to the taxes imposed by such sections 2 and 4 and shall be administered and collected in the same manner as such taxes. All of the provisions of this resolution relating to or applicable to the administration and collection of the taxes imposed by such sections 2 and 4 shall apply to the additional taxes imposed by this section, including the applicable transitional provisions, limitations, special provisions, exemptions, exclusions, refunds and credits as are set forth in this resolution, with the same force and effect as if those provisions had been incorporated in full into this section and had expressly referred to the additional taxes imposed by this section.

SECTION 2. Paragraph (B) of subdivision (1) of Section 11 of Resolution No. 67-190 enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Livingston on November 30, 1967, imposing sales and use taxes, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

B) With respect to the additional tax of one percent imposed for the period beginning June 1, 2003, and ending November 30, 2017, in respect to the use of property used by the purchaser in this county prior to June 1, 2003.

SECTION 3. Subdivision (c) of section 14 of Resolution No. 67-190, enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Livingston on November 30, 1967, imposing sales and use taxes, as amended, is amended to read as follows: (c) Notwithstanding subdivision (a) or (b) of this section or any contrary provision of law, all net collections from the additional one percent rate of sales and compensating use taxes imposed for the period beginning June 1, 2003, and ending November 30, 2017, shall be used to pay the county's expenses for Medicaid. Such net collections shall be deposited in a special fund created by the County separate and apart from any other funds and accounts of the County. Any and all remaining net collections from such additional one percent tax, after the Medicaid expenses are paid, shall be deposited by the County in the general fund of the County for any county purpose.

SECTION 4. This enactment shall take effect December 1, 2015.
