# OLD BUSINESS:

#### 1. Minutes

#### Other Business

#### A. Solar Installations

George reported that the Town is now enacting a one-year moratorium on solar installations to allow time to study the issues and develop appropriate regulations. #### B. Self-Storage Businesses

Self-Storage units are not presently listed as an allowable business in any district in Lima. This fact was discussed and some options were considered. The discussion is to be continued.

Various aspects of the subject were discussed. George asked for Board Members to volunteer for a sub-committee to study needed changes to go into an update for the Comprehensive plan. The stated intent was for the revised Comprehensive Plan to form the base of future Code updates, following Public Hearings and Board approvals. Subcommittee
