## **DECEMBER 2012 NEWLETTER**

**SNOW:** As we approach the winter season, we would like to remind everyone that parking on Village streets from **2 AM** to **6 AM** is prohibited. If you have a fire hydrant in front of your residence, please help our Volunteer Fire Dept. and keep it cleared of snow.

**CHRISTMAS TREES:** The Village crew will once again be picking up Christmas trees this year. Please place them by the roadside and we will get them as time permits.

**BRUSH:** The Village crew picks up brush three (3) times a year (April July, and September). Please do not put out brush at any other time, as it will not be picked up.

**CODE ENFORCEMENT:** Wood stoves and chimneys should be checked and cleaned on a regular basis.

**WATER/SEWER RELEVY:** re-levy cut off date is Feb. 25, 2013. All unpaid water and sewer bills will be re-levied onto the 2013-14 village taxes after 2/25/13.

**HUNTING:** Hunting of any kind is prohibited in the Village of Lima. (Local Law # 5 of 2007).

**LIMA AMBULANCE: URGENT!** Ambulance drivers are needed, particularly during daytime hours. Must be at least 25 yrs. old with a clean driver's license. We will train. Please call 582-1612 or 624-5381 for information.

**WATER LEAKS:** Check your toilets for leaks by putting a few drops of red food coloring in the tank, watch for a few minutes to see if color shows up in the bowl. It is not uncommon to lose up to 100 gls. a day from one of these otherwise invisible leaks. Use your water meter to detect hidden leaks. Simply turn off all taps and water using appliances, then check the meter after 15 minutes. If it moved, you have a leak.

**NY-ALERT:** New York State's All-Hazards Alert and Notification System is a web based portal that allows State agencies, local governments, emergency service agencies to provide emergency alerting information and private notifications to a defined audience (local, county, regional or statewide).
