BRUSH PICK-UP: will be during the week of July 19th. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before July 19th at 7:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of Sept. 20th.

SUMMER HOURS: Through Labor Day (Sept. 6th) the village office will be open from 7 am to noon and from 1 pm to 3 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. Wednesdays from 9 am to noon.

PESTICIDES: Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.

CEO: Only three (3) garage sales are allowed per address per year. Please remove your Garage Sale signs after your sale. Pool permits are required for all pools over 24 inches in height. No out door burning in the Village of Lima.

FIRE HYDRANTS: Hydrants will be flushed the week of Sept. 13th from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

WWTP: We need your help to keep our Wastewater Treatment system operating efficiently. Please do not discard the following into the sanitary sewer collection system: Clorox disinfecting wipes, cooking oil and grease, feminine sanitary products, dental floss, Q-tips, fabric softener dryer sheets, plastic of any kind and anything that does not decompose. These items contribute to sewage blockages in homes, the sanitary sewer collection system and the wastewater treatment facility. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
