### MARCH 2016

**BRUSH PICK-UP:** will be during the week of April 18 – 22. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before Apr. 18<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be the week of July 18<sup>th</sup>. Leaves will be picked up if placed in biodegradable bags. See more information on reverse.

**FIRE HYDRANTS:** Hydrants will be flushed the week of April 11<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> from 7:30 am to 3:30 pm. Please excuse the inconvenience, as the water may be riley during this time.

**FIRE WORKS:** The Village and Town are providing fireworks on Monday, July 4<sup>th</sup>, at Mark Tubbs Park starting at 9:45 pm.

**PESTICIDES:** Please inform your neighbors when putting down lawn chemicals.

**BUILDING INSPECTOR:** Spring is almost here! As you think about home improvements this year, please don't forget to obtain building permits, fence permits or pool permits. Pools are defined as any container (blow up pools included) that are capable of holding 24" or more of water depth. A pool also requires a protective fence around it. **HFL SUMMER RECREATION:** The camp will be located at HFL High School and bus transportation from and to the Lima Primary School will be available each day of the program. Senior Citizen (65 years of age or older) can arrange for pick-up by calling the village office at 624-2210 by 4 pm on May 17<sup>th</sup> and pick-up will be on May 19<sup>th</sup>.

## VILLAGE DATES – 2016

We schedule a **BRUSH PICK-UP** three (3) times a year. This year they are April 18-22, July 18-22 and September 19-23. Please have your brush out before **8:00 am on the Monday** morning beginning the week or you will miss pick-up. Leaves, Walnuts and Grass Clippings will **NOT** be picked up unless in biodegradable paper bags. **Please do not put brush out except during brush pick-up weeks.**

**Hydrant flushing** is April 11<sup>th</sup> – 15<sup>th</sup> and September 12<sup>th</sup> – 16<sup>th</sup>.

**VILLAGE CLEAN-UP DAYS** will be May 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> from 8:00 am until noon at the Village Barns located at 7362 Dublin Ave.

**Memorial Day Parade** will be May 30<sup>th</sup> starting at 9:30 am.

**July 4<sup>th</sup> Fireworks** will be at Mark Tubbs Park at 9:45 pm.

**Crossroads Festival** will be August 6<sup>th</sup> and the 2<sup>nd</sup> annual Blues Festival will be Aug. 5<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup>.

Scheduled **LEAF PICK-UP** begins around October 17<sup>th</sup> and ends November 21<sup>st</sup> or after the first snowfall. Once again walnuts will not be picked up unless in **BIODEGRADABLE BAGS**. Also please do **NOT** put brush or debris in the leaf piles. We have found lumber, metal, large sticks as well as even a baseball bat in the piles. This will break the leaf machine and stop leaf pick up. If you do have some brush debris, put it in a separate pile next to the leaves and we will try to pick it up depending on available time.
