DECEMBER 2014 NEWSLETTER

PARKING: As we approach the winter season, please be aware that on-street parking is prohibited between 2 am and 6 am on all village streets, regardless of signage that may permit overnight parking, during snowfalls in excess of 3 inches. This will allow the Village crew to complete snow removal operations. Cars left on the street will be eligible for towing at owner's expense. If you have a fire hydrant in front of your residence, please help our Volunteer Fire Dept. and keep it cleared of snow.

CHRISTMAS TREES: The Village crew will once again be picking up Christmas trees this year. Please place them by the roadside and we will get them as time permits.

LOCKBOX: The Village and Town of Lima have installed a lockbox for your convenience. It is located on the wall next to the side door. Please be mindful of due dates and label envelopes with either Village or Town. The lockbox will be checked every morning at 8 AM.

HUNTING: Hunting of any kind is prohibited in the Village of Lima (Local Law #5 of 2007).

WATER/SEWER RELEVY: Re-levy cut off date is Feb. 23, 2015. All unpaid water and sewer bills will be re-levied onto the 2015-16 village taxes after 2/23/2015.

CHICKENS: The Village Trustees have approved a pilot program to allow chickens to be kept in the Village based on resident requests. This program will allow a maximum of ten properties to keep no more than six chickens each for a one-year trial period starting January 2015. A permit is required to keep chickens. The ten permits to be issued during the pilot program will be available on a first come first serve basis. Contact the Building Inspector now to sign up for the ten available permits. Please visit the Village website and click on Local Law #3 to read all of the requirements contained in the pilot program.
