### SEPTEMBER 2011 NEWSLETTER

**BRUSH PICK-UP:** will be during the week of Sept. 19<sup>th</sup>. All brush (only brush will be picked up) must be cut in manageable lengths (no larger than 6" in diameter) and placed parallel to the roadside in neat piles before Sept. 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 am. The village will only make one (1) trip down each street. The next brush pick-up will be in April. Leaves will be picked up if placed in biodegradable bags.

**LEAF PICK-UP:** Please put your leaves (only leaves, no brush) by the edge of the road, not in the road or covering drainage ditches or catch basins. We will pick up leaves until the first snowfall or December 1<sup>st</sup>. After Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> leaves must be in **biodegradable** bags only.

**CEO:** Remember to have your chimney cleaned and checked prior to using your fireplace or pellet stove. Remember to check the batteries in your smoke detectors.

**HUNTING:** Hunting of any kind is prohibited in the Village of Lima (Local Law # 5 of 2007).

**WATER RATES:** The City of Rochester has raised its wholesale rate for water by .02/1000 gallons of water. The village's base water rate will now be \$43.90. An additional \$3.66 will be charged for every 1,000 gallons over 10,000 gallons used.
